TO ASSURE EVERYONE A PLEASANT AND SAFE VACATION, PLEASE ABIDE BY THESE GUIDELINES:

- Alcoholic Beverages: Acceptable in moderation on your site only.
- Campsites: Only one camping unit per site.
- Check in/out time: 3:00 p.m. Monday-Sat. 5:00 p.m. on Sundays or Holidays (if site is available).
- Fires: Only in fire rings which may not be moved.
- **Firewood:** For sale by shed. Please use self-pay box or pay during store hours.
- **Fishing:** No license is required. You may keep the bluegills, they are very tasty. You **MUST** throw back all bass. No fishing in the swimming pond. **BAIT** for sale during store hours.
- **Garbage:** Place in plastic bags and deposit in dumpster near exit. Thanks for cleaning up your site.
- **Kayaks and stand up paddle boards:** available for use, inquire at office. Personal watercraft not allowed.
- Motorized off-road vehicles: Not allowed on property.
- Pets: QUIET pets under control and on a leash at all times are allowed. Please clean up after them and never leave them unattended.
- Quiet Hours: Must be respected from 10:30 p.m. to 8:00 a.m. No loud talking, radios, etc. may disturb your closest neighbor.
- **Store Hours**: Are posted at the store and are also announced.
- **Swimming: REMEMBER** Tri Ponds has a 2 bathing suit policy. One for pool and a different one for the pond.
- **No Lifeguard on duty.** A parent must watch own children at all times.
- **Trees:** Cutting, injuring, or driving nails into trees is prohibited. Enjoy the beautiful variety of trees at Tri Ponds.
- **Visitors Policy**: A fee of \$2.00 will be charged to each guest of registered campers. Children 3 years and younger are free. Please pay your fee during store hours.
- Washrooms: Children should be accompanied by an adult. Please help us keep the washrooms clean.
- **WE** do reserve the right to ask anyone to leave (without a refund) for inappropriate behavior: excessive noise, disrespect of property, etc.
